

Sullivan Saddle Club Regular Meeting Minutes 4/7/2016

Meeting called to order at 7:02 by Kelly Onder.

Treasurer Report

Beginning balance was \$2,470.81, debits were \$104.25, credits were \$80.00, and the balance was \$2,446.56. Motion to accept was made by Brian Thunberg. Jeremy Bandy seconded.

Show Committee Report

- One more open show judge is needed.
- A motion was made to purchase approximately \$120.00 in additional ribbons from Hodges Badge Company. Chelsey Kriegel moved to accept and Myra Modglin seconded.
- There is a work day scheduled for 9AM on 4/23. A motion was made to purchase a replacement horn for the cook shack from Radio Shack. Leanne Atkins moved to accept and Chelsey Kriegel seconded. Work to be done includes mounting the new horn, repairing the cavaletti, tamping down the timer stands, velcroing the timer eyes to the stands, picking up deadfall and painting.
- The show committee has chosen to do year end awards for members only.
- The club website will be down for maintenance.

Old Business

- Jack Medling mentioned Boast's signage is missing from the arena fence and Petersen's sign needs to be taken down. Medling requested that the club honor a commitment to post Bink Blankenship's signage in exchange for the original arena creation work done by Blankenship. The club agreed to post his signage for the 2016 and 2017 seasons.
- Jack Medling requested payment for the show book creation be made to Josh Medling as soon as possible in the amount of \$100.00 and an estimated \$300.00 for printed show books due upon pick up. A motion was made to pay the requested costs. Mary Loomis moved to accept and Pam Ramsey seconded.
- Jack Medling reminded the members that the tree between the arena and Maddox Drive has dead limbs that need to be trimmed. Kelly Onder will contact Dave Wall regarding the trimming and the tree will be marked for identification purposes.

- Members have donated raffle items. The show committee hopes to hold one raffle per show. Mary Loomis and Brian Thunberg will handle organizing for the raffles.

- The members approved Jack Medling's request to borrow club tables to seat the parade judges during the fair. Medling asked for volunteers to judge the parade. Pam Ramsey, Barb Vancil and Jeremy Bandy volunteered. Jack Vancil volunteered to help with parade lineup.
- The cook shack will be open for the 6/22 Youth Show and 6/24 Bull Bash during the fair.
